



STEP I

Start the installation under the passenger side of the vehicle. Locate the front (3) factory studs along the inner side of the body panel, (Fig 1). Use a wire brush or thread chaser die to remove excess paint or undercoating from threaded studs as necessary.



Move along the inner body panel to the center and rear mounting locations and repeat Step 1 to prepare all mounting studs, (Fig 2).









STEP 3


Carefully unwrap and select the Passenger/right Side Armor Assembly. Use the illustration above to help identify the correct Side Armor Assembly.




With assistance, line up the Side Armor over the mounting studs. Attach the Side Armor Assembly to the (9) factory studs with (9) 8mm Flat Washers and (9) 8mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figs 3-6). Leave brackets loose at this time.

STEP 5

Level and adjust the Side Armor as necessary and fully tighten all hardware.



Repeat Steps 1-5 for Driver/left Side Armor installation.

STEP 7

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
